Does it happen that you want to know more about the history and heritage of a town and don't know where to get authentic data quickly and easily?


Visit the www.documenta-pannonica.eu web portal! The digital collection provides an insight into the cultural heritage of more than 120 settlements, from Lendava in Prekmurje Region to Szombathely in Vas County.

Did you know that:



Located at the Maribor Regional Archives.

There was a Gothic church in Goričko, Sv. Jurij? *On April 10, 1925, the nave was demolished but the presbytery and belfry were spared;*

There is a mummy in Lendavske gorice, in the Trinity Chapel? *It is the mummy of Mihály Hadik, who died in 1733. His body was naturally mummified in this well-ventilated tomb;*

Opera singer Mária Németh was born in Körmend? *Between the two World Wars, she was the star of the Vienna Opera House, the Staatsoper, and also appeared in the film Halló Budapest;*

In Rábagyarmat, married women wore a special headdress, the so-called „főkötő“?

These are just a few of the things of interest things from our digital collection. Take a look at the digital collection and get acquainted with the diverse cultural heritage of Prekmurje and Vas counties!

The digital collection was created in a cross-border collaboration of four heritage preservation institutions, two museums and two archives. Most of the resources in the *e-documenta Pannonica* digital collection come from these institutions' own collections.

The **Pomurje Museum Murska Sobota (Pomurski muzej Murska Sobota)** is located in the Renaissance castle of Murska Sobota. It is the central institution for preserving the regional cultural heritage of the Prekmurje Region. In the museum, visitors can see archeological, historical, art historical and ethnological objects.

Maribor Regional Archives (Pokrajinski arhiv Maribor) preserves and stores the archival material of Prekmurje Region and the north-eastern part of Slovenia. In the archive you can see parchment diplomas, old photos, postcards and posters, many manuscripts and much more.

The illustrated land register of the land areas of the Maribor Minorites under mountain law was created between 1778 and 1814. Applies to vineyards leased under the mountain law.

As a central, regional institution, the **Savaria County Municipal Museum (Savaria Megyei Hatókörű Városi Múzeum)** takes care of the preservation of the movable heritage of Vas County. The museum has a rich collection of archeology, history, ethnography and natural sciences. In addition to the central museum facility, visitors can visit six further external units of the institution.

The Hungarian National Archives - Vas County Archives (Magyar Nemzeti Levéltár – Vas Megyei Levéltár) preserves and stores the archival sources of Vas County. Most of the resources offered by the County Archives are public, official documents: national censuses, municipal and personal documents, but there are also private notes, drawings (sketches) and photographs.

Ten reasons to visit the web portal:


- 1 It is available for anyone, anytime, anywhere,




STEP 1:

In 1734 János Horváth Szentgyörgyi renovated the church in Répcsesztygyörgy. The family archives have kept some blueprints of this construction. The plan presented here shows suggestions for the shape of the spire, which are typically Baroque. The church has been renovated several times since then, today its tower has a completely different shape.




